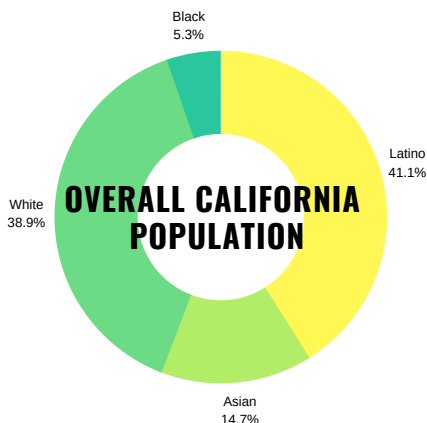
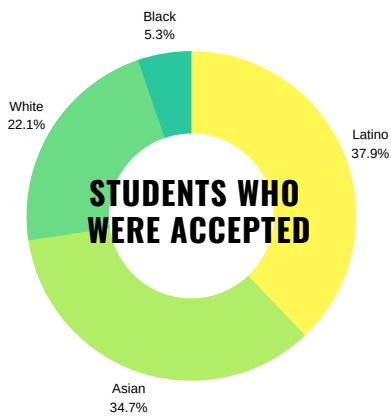
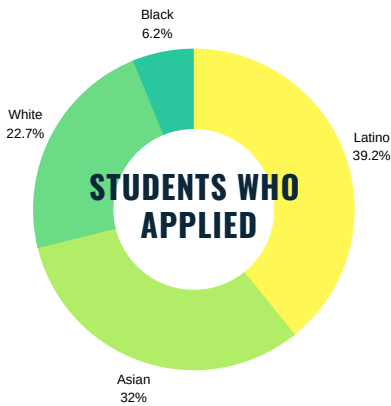


VOTE NO ON PROP 16 KEEP DISCRIMINATION ILLEGAL

Proposition 16, on the California ballot this November, is a constitutional amendment to allow college admissions based on race at the University of California and California State Universities. It also legalizes state government hiring and contracting based on race.

Resolved by the Assembly, the Senate concurring, That the Legislature of the State of California at its 2019–20 Regular Session commencing on the third day of December 2018, two-thirds of the membership of each house concurring, hereby proposes to the people of the State of California, that the Constitution of the State be amended as follows: That Section 31 of Article I thereof is repealed.
